9 AM Scoring 24 targets -- Unmarked distances, double scoring.
Sunday: 8-8:45 AM, warm-up practice.
9 AM, Scoring 24 targets at marked distances, double scoring.
Awards Ceremony after all shooting is completed.

Divisions: Men and Women Olympic recurve bow, Bare bow, and Compound bow
Masters (50+), Masters (70+), Senior (19-49)
Long bow with wood arrows (must have at least three long bow for division)
Cross bow with wood bolts, SCA style cross bow only
JOAD Divisions:
2010 Yeoman, born in 2001 or later
2010 Bowman, born in 1998, 1999, 2000
2010 Cub, born in 1996 or 1997
2010 Cadet, born 1994 or 1995
2010 Junior, born in 1992 or 1993

Fees: Arizona/NAA adult member: \$35.00
Arizona/NAA JOAD members: \$25.00
Non-Arizona/NAA/guests: \$35.00
NOTE: You must be an Arizona resident to win a state championship. Guest
are welcome in all divisions.
Usery Mountain Park charges six dollars (\$6.00) per CAR per day to enter.
Carpool if you can. There is a separate \$2.00 fee for archery range usage.

Registration: Registration sign-up is available on line or down load form. Please make
sure you complete all items on the registration form. Registration deadline is Thursday,
October 7, 2010. Registering on line allows us to be fully prepared for the numbers
planning to attend. You may register on site.

Rules: FITA Field Rules in effect. **Dress code will be enforced -- NO CAMO!**
Blue jeans and cargo pants are allowed for field. You are shooting in a desert, suggested
footwear is hiking shoes or good cross training shoes. Do not Wear sandals.

Distances: Adult distances: Olympic recurve and Compound shoot at Red markers.
Bare bow and JOAD Juniors shoot at Blue markers.
JOAD Cadets and younger shoot at yellow markers.
Long bow with wood arrows shoot from yellow markers.
Cross bows (SCA style) wood bolts shoot from blue marks.

**Each Round consists of 24 targets set at the following distances.
All distances are in meters.**

Unmarked Distances on first day

Target size

20cm. Yellow peg: 5-15m	Blue: 5-15m	Red: 10-20m
40cm. Yellow peg: 10-15m	Blue: 10-20m	Red: 15-25m
60cm. Yellow peg: 15-20m	Blue: 15-30m	Red: 20-35m
80cm. Yellow peg: 20-35m	Blue: 30-45m	Red: 35-55m

Marked Distances on second day

Target size

20cm. Yellow pegs: 5-15m	Blue: 5-15m	Red: 10-20m
40cm. Yellow pegs: 10-20m	Blue: 15-25m	Red: 20-30m
60cm. Yellow pegs: 20-30m	Blue: 30-40m	Red: 35-45m
80cm. Yellow pegs: 30-40m	Blue: 40-50m	Red: 50-60m
