



Junior World Team Support Shoot



Papago Benefit 600 Round !!

- Who:** JOAD, NAA Adult, NFAA and newcomer target archers are welcome – All ages.
- Why:** The NAA has asked all JOAD clubs to host a special benefit shoot to help fund the USA Junior World Team in Great Britain this summer. **ALL** donations will be forwarded to the NAA, the Papago FITA Archers will cover **ALL** tournament cost (target faces, wear & tear).
- Where:** Papago Park Archery Range in Phoenix, NW of McDowell Rd. and Galvin Parkway (64th St.).
- When:** **Saturday June 5th, 2004.**
7:30 AM Self-Serve Setup and Registration.
8 AM Practice 'till 8:45 AM
9 AM **4 ends of 5 arrows at each of the 3 distances for a total of 60 arrows.**
Appx. Noon Finish

Setup & facility: Archers and family members to set up and take down targets, flags targets, etc. 52" tournament target bails on wood stands will be used, lanes & range are marked. Bring a chair, shade canopy, water, beverages, snacks and food. Event will be run regardless of the weather (rain or shine, wind or calm) unless unsafe or unhealthy. **There is NO water on site** (water cooler will be available)!

Rules: NAA / FITA dress code & membership is optional but recommended. Standard NAA / FITA tournament / range / scoring rules will be in effect. This is not an official NAA tournament – just a fun practice event. Target sizes is 122cm (48"), 5 color 10 ring. 20 arrows will be shot at each distance for a total of 60 arrows. Distances used:

Papago Youth: JOAD Yeoman & Bowman, up to 12yr old	20 / 15 / 10 meters
Junior: JOAD Cub & Cadet, 13 ~16yr old	40 / 30 / 20 meters
Adult: JOAD Junior, NAA Senior & Master 17yr old & up	60 / 50 / 40 meters

How Much: Suggested Donation, made at the range: The NAA is asking for \$25 per person, we will accept any size donation (\$5, \$10, \$15, \$20... what ever you feel is appropriate). There are **NO** park or range fees!

We have up to 10 target bails & lanes - There will be up to three archers per target and 2 shooting lines if needed for a total of as many of 60 archers.

This is the fourth in a series of different archery events (1/2 FITA, 600, Olympic & Indoor rounds) shot at Papago Park in 2004 for a series championship. Awards will be given for series champions at the end of the series based on class participation.
